Please will all children bring a teddy into school on Monday which can be left in school until half term. If the weather is nice, the children will be doing judo sessions outside with each other. If the weather is not suitable, they will be doing judo sessions with their teddies in the hall.

Breakfast and After School Clubs

Breakfast and after school clubs have started up again. Please remember to book by 4pm the day before either club is required. Please note, **FOR MONDAY CLUBS bookings must be made before 4pm on FRIDAY.** Entry to breakfast club is strictly between 7.45 & 7.55am and after school club children can be picked up at 4.30pm when club ends.

Absence

If your child is off school for any reason, please make sure you phone through to school **daily** to update us until they return. (This also includes if your child is self-isolating.)

School Dinners

Our caterers have informed us there will be a small price increase on school dinners after Easter and the cost for meals supplied from 19th April onwards will be £2.55 per meal.

Cut off date for ordering dinners

Due to a change in supplier, our catering staff have had to change the way that they order food for school dinners. As a result, meals now need to be ordered a clear week in advance (or as far in advance as the system allows) whenever possible to enable more accurate quantities of food to be ordered by our catering staff. Thank you.
