Covid 19 Test Reporting

In the last week, we have had no children taking a Covid test. Thank you to parents/carers for your support in continuing to wear a face covering at drop off & collection times. We continue to follow all government & Public Health guidelines relating to COVID-19.

Absence

If your child is off school for any reason, please make sure you phone through to school **daily** to update us until they return. (This also includes if your child is self-isolating.)

In addition, if your child is off school and has got a school dinner ordered, please make sure that you cancel their dinner to avoid being charged for a meal not taken.

Cut off date for ordering dinners

Please order school dinners one week in advance (or as far in advance as the system allows) whenever possible to enable more accurate quantities of food to be ordered by our catering staff.

Breakfast and After School Clubs

Please remember to book by 4pm the day before either club is required. Please note, **FOR MONDAY CLUBS bookings must be made before 4pm on FRIDAY**. Entry to breakfast club is strictly between 7.45 & 7.55am and after school club children can be picked up at 4.30pm when club ends.
