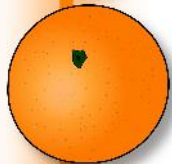
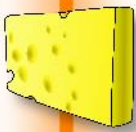


KS1 Autumn Term 1 – Food



In Literacy Y1 /2 will be looking at “How to make Apple pie and see the World” by Marjorie Priceman and related stories and poetry about food around the world, focusing on imaginative and journal writing.

In Music we will be looking at music from the UK and learning to make sounds with different instruments and our own bodies that relate to different moods and how music is used in celebrations.

In PE we will be focusing on dance. We will learn some basic street dance and understand how dance is used with food at celebrations and to keep healthy.

In Science we will be focusing on the weather and seasons and how this effects what plants and food will grow and in which areas. We will learn about the life of plants through this too.

In computing Y1/2 will learn about technology outside the classroom, focusing on barcodes in shops. We will also begin to research our topic using the internet safely.

In DT we will be focusing on cooking and nutrition, learning how to make healthy meals and healthy menus.

In Art and Design we will be focusing on texture and pattern and designing our own food packaging.

In RE we will look at harvest and what Jesus taught us about sharing, especially parables such as the Loaves and Fishes.

In Geography we will look at the 4 countries of the UK and compare seasonal weather patterns. We will look at the world and hot and cold countries and how what they eat differs due to climate.
