

KS2 Spring Term 2015

Extreme Weather

In **Science** Year 3 and 4 will be looking at plants and how weather affects their growth. Year 5 and 6 will be focusing on the Earth, Moon and space and how it affects our weather.

In **Geography** Year 3 and 4 will be looking at the water cycle and how it effects people. Year 5 and 6 will be focusing on Water and Its effects on landscapes and people, including local flooding.

In **Literacy** Year 3 and 4 will be reading "storm" by Kevin Crossley Holland which looks at surviving a storm. Year 5 and 6 will be reading "Floodland" by Marcus Sedgewick which looks at the effects of climate change.

In **PE** Years 3/4 5/6 will be developing extreme fitness with onside through circuit training and will also be swimming.

In **DT** Year 3 and 4 will be designing and implementing water wheels and windmills focusing on wind and wave power Year 5 and 6 will be looking at structures to withstand different forms of weather.

In **History** Year 5 and 6 will be covering Historical enquiry and a Local history study on our coast line and the affects of the weather.

In **RE** and **ART** Year 3 and 4 will be looking at Holy Books including the Bible and Quran. Year 5 and 6 will be looking at faiths through art.

In **Computing** Year 3 and 4 will be looking at Databases based around weather. Year 5 and 6 will be programming and developing a weather station with scratch

In **MFL** 3 and 4 and Year 5 and 6 will be learning about weather and seasons in French and Spanish.
