School Dinner Price Increase

Unfortunately, the cost of school dinners will be increasing from 1st September to £2.79 per meal. As a school we have been fighting this increase and whilst we are being charged this new price from 1st June, we took the decision not to increase the price to parents until September.

PE

From September we are going to back to our "pre-covid" way of doing PE. All children, nursery included, will need to bring their PE kits in a bag on a Monday (or the first day back after a holiday period) to leave in school. By doing this we will be able to increase the amount of PE that children will be able to take part in during the week. PE kits will then be sent home with your child on a Friday afternoon. Children will no longer wear their PE kits to school on a set day each week.

As children will now be getting changed in school for PE, please ensure that **every** item of clothing/footwear is clearly labelled with their name on as, however hard we try to make sure they keep their clothes in their own bags, we always end up with a random polo shirt/jumper/PE t-shirt left lying around that nobody seems to own!

Primary Science Quality Mark

A huge congratulations to Mrs. Heywood and Mrs. Kennedy who have been working extremely hard across the school in order to achieve the Primary Science Quality Mark (PSQM) for Moor Row School. They have shown great perseverance and resilience; however, as a school we could not have achieved this recognition if your children had not worked as hard as they have done this year as samples of their work also had to be submitted to the panel as evidence to support Mrs Heywood and Mrs Kennedy's own hard work.

Just 250 Primary Science Quality Marks have been awarded to infant, junior, primary, middle and special schools across the UK this year to celebrate their commitment to excellence in science teaching and learning. So far, since its national launch in 2010, over 4000 schools across the UK have achieved a prestigious Primary Science Quality Mark.
