Fire Service Visit

The children who worked with our visitors demonstrated the school values of manners, respect & success. We hope the Fire Fighters will come back to work with Year 1 / 2 and Year 3 / 4.

COVID-19

This week we have had 3 confirmed positive cases of COVID. As a school we would like to thank all parents & carers for their continued support with following guidelines in relation to COVID-19. This week has been a challenging one in making decisions to best keep our school community and the wider community as safe as possible. Thank you to those families who have followed our enhanced procedures in managing a possible outbreak. I do have to record positive cases to Cumbria Public Health and they give advice to follow. I understand that this can be a frustrating when procedures may not be the same as other schools or appear to fit in with Government guidance, but one size does not fit all in the world of COVID. Swimming

Swimming is the only sport specifically outlined within the national curriculum physical education programme of study and all primary schools must provide swimming and water safety lessons in either Key Stage 1 or 2. At Moor Row School we will provide swimming and water safety lessons in Key Stage 2.

By the end of Key Stage 2, each pupil is required to be able to do the following:

- * Perform safe self-rescue in different water based situations
- * Swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of **at least** 25 metres
- * Use a range of strokes effectively, for example, front crawl, backstroke and breaststroke.

After Christmas we will be taking Years 5 & 6 for a 2 week block of swimming lessons. Each child in Year 5 & 6 will need to bring their swimming costume, towel and goggles each afternoon from Monday 10th January to Friday 21st January inclusive. A reminder will be sent out nearer the time. (Year 3 & 4 class will be going swimming at the end of the Spring term, further details will follow next term.)

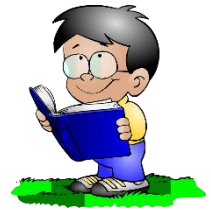
Reader of the Week Awards
