School App

Thank you to everyone who has downloaded the app over the past couple of weeks. Did you know you can use the app to do the following:

- Update any contact information, such as change of contacts, addresses, telephone numbers
- Update any medical information held for your child
- Report absence through the app which is much quicker and easier than phoning or emailing school (you can report the absence at anytime, you do not need to wait for school to open at 8.30am)
- Messages will also be sent via the app instead of by text message which also saves the school money as every text message sent costs us to send, whereas on the app all messages are free!!

The feedback we have had so far indicates that the app is a success so, if you haven't downloaded it yet – what are you waiting for? Please check back through your emails for the information which will contain your access code. If you haven't got the email or have deleted it, please let Mrs Bone know and she will resend the information out to you.
