#### **Monday 19<sup>th</sup> September – School Closed (Bank Holiday)**

Please remember that school is closed on Monday 19<sup>th</sup> September as it is now a bank holiday due to the funeral of the late Queen Elizabeth II taking place on this day. School will re-open on Tuesday as normal. Any dinners that were ordered for Monday have been cancelled and the money has been refunded to your Lunchshop account.

#### **School Absence due to illness**

#### **School Absence due to an appointment**

Where possible, please try and make any appointments out of school time so as not to interrupt your child’s learning. However, we do appreciate that it is not always possible for this to happen so if your child needs time off school due to having an appointment, please make sure that your child brings a copy of the appointment letter/card with

them to school to show their teacher. Thank you.

#### **Flu Vaccinations**

Flu Vaccination consent forms have been sent home this week for all children except for those in the Nursery class. Please can we ask that you return your completed form to school by Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> September so that the Immunisation Team know if you have given consent or not for your child to have the vaccine.

Flu Vaccinations will take place in school on Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> November.

Nursery children will be able to receive the vaccine at their local GP Practice.

## **Packed Lunches**

If your child is bringing a packed lunch to school, including if they ALWAYS bring a packed lunch, please log in to Lunchshop and select the “Packed lunch from home option” for each day. This can be done on a weekly basis in advance so there is no need to log in each day. By doing this it will mean that we are no longer interrupting learning time while the teachers check to see if each child has chosen the packed lunch option or if they have forgotten to order a dinner from home.

Can we also remind parents that due to allergies within school we are a nut free school – this includes chocolate spread such as Nutella. Some sweets and lollies have also sneaked their way into some lunchboxes. It would be appreciated if these are not included as part of a packed lunch. Lollies are a choking hazard and as part of our Health & Safety we will not allow children to eat them.

## **Year 3 & 4, 5 & 6 Residentials**

Letters have gone out to both classes regarding residentials for Summer Term 2023. These trips have now been set up on Lunchshop in a way that you can make several smaller payments instead of having to pay the full amount in one go. If anyone has any financial issues which may make payment difficult, please have a confidential chat with either Mrs Bone or Mrs Beavis.
