



Neurodiversity Day - Monday 29th April 2024

Dear Parents.

Firstly I hope you are all well and recovered after the Easter break.



I wanted to write to you all to introduce myself to those who aren't familiar with me, I'm Katy Blacklock and have 3 children who attend Moor Row School, in most recent month's I have been actively supporting the school as a volunteer.

On the 29th April, I will be attending school to deliver an awareness day on the topic of Neurodiversity. I was diagnosed at 26 with Autism, and in the following year ADHD having spent numerous years under the care of the NHS mental health services, all three of my children also have a neurodivergent diagnosis.

This day will include short workshops around awareness of Neurodivergent diagnosis, understanding behaviours, coping mechanisms, peer support and terminology. Whilst I appreciate this may be a difficult topic for some, I really do hope it brings comfort and understanding for all, creating a inclusive environment for both teachers, parents, and students.

All topics have been discussed and reviewed by the teachers, and the children will be encouraged to speak if they wish, no question is a silly question.

I wanted to write to you all as an ambassador for MIND UK, OCD UK, Autism & ADHD advocate to offer support and guidance should you ever need it. Navigating a family is hard regardless, and whilst embracing on our journey we have found the most rewarding support is getting to know and understand others.

I hope you find this letter well, and if you have any questions please do not hesitate to contact the school in which I will be happy to aid where I can. Please also reach out if you would like any further guidance, information, coping strategies or interested in workshops. I hope to implement these in the new school year but have a bank of resources currently available.
