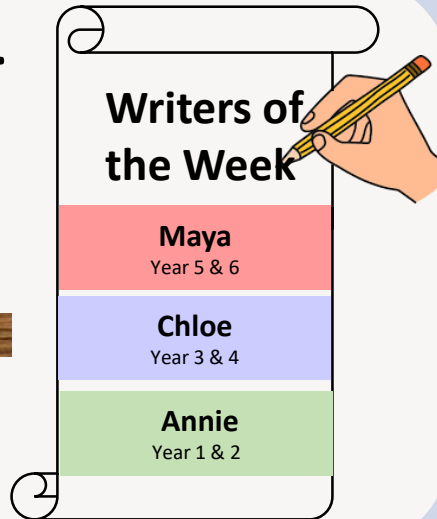
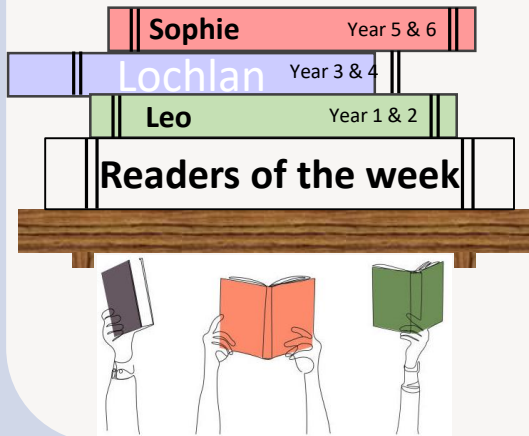

PhunkyFoods Top Tip 3: Make snack swaps!
