

#### **Breakfast Club**

There have been a number of mornings recently where children who have not been booked in have turned up at school requiring this service. Breakfast club only runs if we have children booked in using the correct channels which is via SchoolHub and should be no later than 3 pm the night before. For a Monday this is 3pm on the Friday before. This system ensures we have adequate staff and breakfast provision available for the children. If your child is not booked in then they could be turned away, not fed and also there is a danger that there will be no staff in school to offer this service. Please support us by booking using the correct Channels to allow to offer the best service possible.

#### Star of the week badges

Please can we ask that everyone checks at home to see if they have any Star of the week badges. We have about 20 badges missing from our collection. By returning the badges — there will be no judgement, we will just be pleased to have them back. This will save us on needing to spend money on these items. Thank you in advance for your co-operation.

#### Uniform, Hair styles, Jewellery & Nail Varnish

We are seeing an increase in the number of children not following the school uniform policy and this can have a detrimental affect on learning as well as having health and safety implications. I have highlighted the main concerns below but a full copy of our Uniform Policy is available on the school website.

- Uniform: the main area of the uniform not being followed is that of P.E kit. Please ensure your child has a correct Moor Row P.E top and not a football shirt.
- Jewellery: Jewellery is not allowed to be worn in school due to Health & Safety. The only exception
  is small stud earrings but these must be removed during all PE lessons and activities. A watch may
  also be worn. We are seeing a number of bracelets / wrist bands coming into school and being
  worn these need to be removed and not worn into school. If you wish your child to wear a small
  object with particular religious, cultural or medical significance, this will be considered by the Head
  teacher please contact me.
- Hairstyles: A number of haircuts are creeping into school which are on the verge of being identified
  as 'Extreme' hairstyles. Please remember children should not have bright hair dyes, shaved
  patterns and Mohicans in school as these can cause distraction in class that is disruptive to learning.
  The shaved patterns are the particular issue creeping into school at present.
- We are getting a number of children attending school wearing make-up, temporary tattoos or nail
  varnish. This is not permitted and again this needs to be removed when the children are in school.

Thank you for your support on these matters to ensure that the focus at school is learning and that the children are as safe as possible.
