



The <u>Curriculum and Assessment Review</u> are asking for suggestions and proposals to help them improve the curriculum and assessment system.

The review panel want to hear:

students, pupils and learners
parents and carers
teachers, tutors and lecturers
headteachers and senior leaders
the wider school, college or university workforce
researchers, academics and education experts

local authority officers
anyone with an interest in the curriculum

This is not a consultation and we are not seeking views on specific recommendations at this stage.

This call for evidence is an important step in the review process. Any information you provide will feed into the review and help the panel to make its first recommendations.
