CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PUPILS – VIDEO CONFERRING

- When selecting a platform for online/virtual teaching, we will ensure that the 'provider' has an appropriate level of security.
- Meetings will be timetabled and senior staff are able to drop in to any virtual meeting at any time – the online version of entering a classroom.
- Pupils should be in living/communal areas – no bedrooms.
- Only appropriate objects and information should be visible during the meeting.
- Staff and pupils should be fully dressed.
- The staff member will act as a moderator; raise any issues of suitability (of dress, setting, behaviour etc.) with the child and/or parent immediately and end the online interaction if necessary.
- Please use wifi to connect to the meeting as video utilises significant amounts of data and can incur mobile data access charges if 4G etc. is used.
- A 'classroom standard' of behaviour is expected from all participants in line with our school Behaviour policy.
- Meetings must not be recorded.
